

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS (2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR)

Per Indiana House Bill 1310 provides that a public school may conduct not more than three virtual student instructional days that do not meet the established requirements. Requirements include any eLearning days beyond three must include 50% of live (virtual) teaching.

Complete and submit the daily or hourly attendance activity as assigned by their teacher(s). • Attendance activities will be due the day they are posted. • However, teachers will follow the terms of IEPs, ILPs, and 504 Plans as determined for individual students.	Log in to Canvas, follow your schedule and participate in live instruction via Google Meet Complete and submit the daily or hourly attendance activity as assigned by their teacher(s). • Attendance activities will be due the day they are posted. • However, teachers will follow the terms of IEPs, ILPs, and 504 Plans as determined for individual students.

Follow the posted due dates as determined by their teachers. There will not be extended due dates unless allowed by the teacher.**Teachers will grant extended time that is documented in a student's IEP or ILP

Complete different types of assignments, quizzes, papers, and projects as assigned by teacher(s):

- assignments might include independent review or practice of previously taught content, OR
- preview activities for upcoming content, OR
- checks for understanding (quiz, assessment, project, etc.) at the end of the daily assignment/module that will count as a grade, OR some combination of these types of submissions.
