Chesterton High School is dedicated to quality education for all students and is committed to developing lifelong learners who will value themselves and others, contribute to their community, and achieve individual success in an ever-changing world.



### OUR SCHOOL

Chesterton Senior High School is a four year comprehensive public school located about 50 miles southeast of Chicago in Chesterton, Indiana. Chesterton has a population of 13,000 and is situated at the very southern tip of Lake Michigan. CHS is part of the Duneland School Corporation, which includes five elementary schools (K-4), two intermediate schools (5-6), one middle school (7-8), and one high school (9-12). CHS is accredited by Cognia, is an Indiana Gold Star Counseling Award recipient, an ASCA Ramp school, and an International Baccalaureate (IB) school. 26% of our students are enrolled in the federal Free/Reduced Lunch program.

CHS is structured using a block schedule. Block scheduling provides each student with seven, 90-minute periods and one 90-minute resource block over two days.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Indiana requires 40 credits for graduation, while CHS requires 42 credits and 47 credits for the Academic Honors Diploma. Students enrolled in the IB program must complete the full IB diploma.
