OUR SCHOOL

Chesterton Senior High School is a four year comprehensive public school located about 50 miles southeast of Chicago in Chesterton, Indiana. Chesterton has a population of 13,000 and is situated at the very southern tip of Lake Michigan. CHS is part of the Duneland School Corporation, which includes five elementary schools (K-4), two intermediate schools (5-6), one middle school (7-8), and one high school (9-12). CHS is accredited by Cognia, is an Indiana Gold Star Counseling Award recipient, an ASCA Ramp school, and an International Baccalaureate (IB) school. 28% of our students are enrolled in the federal Free/Reduced Lunch program.

CHS is structured using a block schedule. Block scheduling provides each student with seven, 90-minute periods and one 90-minute resource block over two days.
